

Student Representative Chair

Purpose: Create connection, communication and collaboration between PAB and the performing arts student body we serve

Benefits:

- ✓ Students gain the experience of leadership and representing their peers.
- ✓ Students are introduced to a non-profit organization and the importance of volunteering.
- ✓ Students acquire a skill and community service valuable for resumes, college applications and their future.
- ✓ The Board gains broader insight on student involvement & viewpoint enhancing the effectiveness of the PAB.
- ✓ The Board creates stronger connections to families and membership by engaging students.
- ✓ The Board becomes a more accurate representation of the program we serve.

How To:

1. One sophomore or junior student from each discipline will be chosen by Discipline Directors to be a PAB Student Rep
2. Term will be one school year
3. Students will attend 2 Board meetings of their choice and will present information to members
4. Students will notify Board one week prior to their attendance
5. Students will only be required to stay for first 30 minutes of meeting or until all students have presented
6. Student Reps photo and bio will be posted on PAB website
7. One Board member will serve as Student Rep Chair

Information for Student Reps to present:

- Bio including achievements, goals and how the SJHHS Performing Arts has influenced their lives
- Meeting reports with discipline & community news, performance dates & follow-ups, ideas, questions

Chair will:

- Request candidates from Discipline Directors
- Share names and photos of selected students to web chairperson and board members
- Inform board about placing students on specific meeting agendas
- Inform students of the duties of their position (see welcome letter under Student Reps)
- Communicate with students on regular basis and keep record of meetings they attended
- Provide any written documentation or recommendations requested by students
